Coating Type:	Water-based modified acrylic with fungicidal additive for use with water-based coating systems
Typical Uses:	Penetrating sealer for porous substrates, aged friable masonry paints, new concrete, rendering, brick, plaster etc.
Colours Available:	Clear finish only (also available with White “Tracer” see 150-429)
Application Rate	Low porosity (i.e. old emulsion paint) Approx. 8-10m ² per litre High porosity (i.e. new brick, concrete) Approx. 4-6m ² per litre (Dependent on porosity, absorption etc.)
Drying Time at 20°C: (Will vary with temperature, air movement etc.)	Touch Dry: 30 minutes Firm Dry: 2 hours Overcoat: 2 hours Drying times will vary depending on humidity, air circulation, ventilation etc.
Packaging:	2.5 litre containers and 5 litre containers
Shelf Life:	2 years in unopened containers, when stored under cover in good storage conditions.
Storage:	Under cover within temperature range of 5°C to 32°C.

Surface Preparation: Remove all loose flaking paint, friable material etc., by scraping, wire brushing etc., to leave sound surfaces. Wash down with detergent water followed by clean water rinse. Allow to dry.

Areas susceptible to fungal growth should be scraped clean and treated with 20% domestic bleach solution followed by clean water rinse.

Application: Apply liberally by brush. Brush well into textured surfaces, mortar courses etc. May be applied by spray to large areas.

Note: Clear Fungicidal Masonry Sealer should **NOT** be applied in wet, damp conditions or if rain is threatened.

Relative humidity should be **less than 85%**. Ambient temperature should be above 5°C until coating has fully dried.

Clean Up: Clean water
