Product Name:	MARCLEAN EXTRA

Coating Type:	Extra strong graffiti removal solution – a blend of suitable solvents together with additives supplied as a gel.
Typical Uses:	For use on certain types of graffiti where the standard cleaner, Marclean GP, is ineffective or slow.
Packaging:	0.5 litre, 1 litre, 2.5 litre and 5 litre lever-lid containers.
Shelf Life:	12 months in unopened containers, when stored under cover in good storage conditions.
Storage:	Under cover within temperature range of 5°C to 32°C.
Application:	<p>Marclean Extra should be applied to the graffiti contaminated surface by brush and allowed to stand for a few minutes. It should then be agitated to break up the graffiti and the excess wiped off. If necessary, repeat the process where the graffiti is still present.</p> <p>On complete removal of the graffiti, thoroughly wash the area with water with a small amount of detergent added.</p> <p>Marclean Extra should only be used on impervious surfaces (i.e. glass, tiles), or surfaces treated with the Margard Anti-Graffiti System.</p> <p>It must not be used on surfaces previously painted with decorative gloss or emulsion paints.</p> <p>Note: Where the surface to be cleaned is plastic or of an unknown type, a small trial area should be treated before large-scale removal is undertaken.</p> <p>Marclean Extra may also be used to remove graffiti from unsealed surfaces such as brick, stone or concrete. However, there may be an “image” of the graffiti damage remaining due to the amount of rubbing and brushing required to remove the stain.</p>

Application continued:

The most **effective** means of removal on unsealed surfaces is by wet abrasive blasting and ideally this should be adapted as a cleaning process prior to sealing with Margard SP Clear Finish.

Once sealed these surfaces can be effectively cleaned with the standard **Marclean GP** Graffiti Remover ref:150-198, or Marclean Extra ref:150-355.
